
How to install driver

- 1: Turn off the printer. Plug the power cable into the power socket on the wall, and then connect the other end of the cable to printer's power socket. Connect the Parallel to USB cable to the port on the printer and on the PC.
- 2. Turn on the printer.
- 3. Run the seagull driver. On the prompt, Windows Printer Driver, select "I accept..." and click "Next".



4. Assign the directory to keep Seagull driver, (for example: C:\Seagull) and click "Next".



5. Click "Finish".



6. Select Install printer drivers and Click "Next"



7. Make sure printer is connected to PC, select "Other" and click "Next":



8. Select model & emulation




